

COVID-19 Procedures

Below are the current COVID-19 procedures for Ogunquit and the State of Maine. We will update this information when it changes-hopefully becoming less restrictive.

All guests who are not a resident of Maine or from an exempted state (list available at <https://www.maine.gov/covid19/>) must complete a Certificate of Compliance form (<https://www.maine.gov/covid19/restartingmaine/keepmainehealthy>) or use the “Pledge to Protect ME” online compliance form at <https://www.pledgeport.app/> . **We can provide the Certificate of Compliance at check-in.** The certificate or “Pledge to protect ME” asks you to certify that you have received a negative COVID-19 test result no longer than 72 hours prior to your arrival, or that you will quarantine in Maine for 14 days (or length of stay, whichever is shorter), or that you have already completed your quarantine in the state of Maine. We will at no time ask to see any test results.

You can also get tested in Maine when you arrive after which you must quarantine until test results are known. While quarantining you can enjoy all outside recreational activities such as going to the beach, walking, hiking, cycling etc. provided you are socially distancing from others. You can not frequent a restaurant but you can take advantage of food delivery, curbside pick-up or take out.

We will continue with the changes we implemented last season for everyone’s health and safety complying with CDC, state and federal guidelines. These include but are not limited to frequent sanitizing of all common areas and surfaces, having sanitizers available at all times, wearing of masks inside the Inn and whenever social distancing is difficult, breakfast pick up to enjoy in one of our many indoor and outdoor areas or to eat in your room. Your health and safety along with our own are paramount to us. We strive to make your time with us enjoyable and safe at all times.

Two weeks prior to arrival we will email you our new check-in procedures which begin by asking you to call us from your car when you arrive to be sure we can give you safe and undivided attention. As part of state and federal guidelines, we have been asked to stop daily housekeeping. Upon your request we are happy to provide fresh towels, amenities or other requests you may have.

Ogunquit, Beautiful Place by the Sea is open and looks forward to welcoming all travelers. Our beach, the Marginal Way, Perkins Cove, shops and restaurants are open with some restrictions.
